

Christmas Tour of Homes



INSIDE: ONE OF THE TALLEST WORKING WINDMILLS IN NORTH AMERICA

Step into the heart of Pella, Iowa's Dutch heritage with an unforgettable, multi-faceted tour centered around the magnificent **Vermeer Windmill**. Standing at a remarkable 124 feet 6 inches from the ground to the tip of its highest sail, this authentic 1850s-style "koren mill" is a proud centerpiece of the community and holds the distinction of being the **tallest working windmill in North America**.

The mill's existence is a testament to Pella's dedication to preserving its roots. It was designed and built by a craftsman in Hoogmade, the Netherlands, then carefully de-assembled, shipped across the ocean, and meticulously re-assembled in downtown Pella in 2002. Named in honor of the Harry and Bernice Vermeer family, whose dream it was to bring a working mill to Pella, it continues to honor the town's agricultural past by grinding wheat into flour using only wind power. This fresh, stone-ground flour is even sold locally and used by town bakeries, allowing visitors to literally taste a piece of Pella's history.

Your visit includes a fascinating five-floor guided journey through the inner workings of the mill. The tour begins at the base, where grain is traditionally brought in for milling. As you ascend, knowledgeable and traditionally-dressed millers are on hand to share the mill's secrets, explaining how the enormous sails and intricate gear system harness the wind to power the grinding stones. This is a genuinely hands-on lesson in historical engineering.


For guests with mobility concerns, the Vermeer Windmill is equipped with an elevator that provides accessible access to the base, the stage/stone floor, and the top observation deck. Please note, however, that while accessibility is a priority, some historic interior levels, such as the authentic Miller's Quarters, are accessible by stairs only.

The Miller's Quarters is a highlight in itself—a carefully recreated living space that shows you what life was like for the miller and their family in the mid-19th century, offering a personal glimpse into the daily rhythm of work and home.

The journey culminates on the highest deck, which not only allows you to stand remarkably close to the giant turning blades but also provides a spectacular panoramic view of the beautifully Dutch-styled downtown Pella.

Your Vermeer Windmill admission also includes a tour of the one-of-a-kind Miniature Dutch Village. This hidden gem is a delightful, exquisitely detailed recreation of life in the Netherlands during the 1840s, complete with miniature buildings and figures that depict all four seasons. It's a work of art, with many components lovingly hand-crafted by volunteers of the Pella Historical Museums, Central College, and Pella Community Schools.

Adjacent to the windmill, your ticket also provides self-guided access to the Pella Historical Village. This 18-building complex delves deeper into the Dutch immigrant experience, featuring everything from a log cabin and a general store to a blacksmith shop and the boyhood home of the famous Western lawman, Wyatt Earp. From the towering height of the working mill to the tiny, intricate scenes of the miniature village, a tour of the Vermeer Windmill complex is an immersive and essential step back in time.



Discover Pella: Beyond the Tulips

Wander down charming streets, explore traditional Dutch windmills, soak in vibrant tulip gardens bursting with color, and immerse yourself in authentic Dutch traditions. Whether you're joining festive celebrations like Kerstmarkt or exploring heritage museums, Pella offers a unique blend of culture, natural beauty, and warm hospitality, making it an unforgettable escape for anyone seeking a taste of Dutch charm.

Pella, where Dutch heritage thrives, windmills turn, and is in bloom from spring until fall. Walking through the streets, you'll find history woven into every corner, from the Scholte House Museum, once home to Pella's founder, Domine Scholte, to the charming Maria's Tea Room inside, where you can sip on tea and enjoy a Dutch coffeetime while hearing about Maria's story. Pella Historical Museums takes you even deeper into the past, with an interactive path in Wyatt Earp's story and the impressive Vermeer Windmill, the largest working windmill in North America, standing tall as a reminder of the town's Dutch roots.

For a relaxing escape, head north of downtown a few blocks to Sunken Gardens Park. This gorgeous park offers a peaceful retreat with its wooden shoe-shaped pond, lush flower beds, and one of our five windmills within the community. Connected to the park is the Tuttle Learning Walk, where signs share the stories of Marion County's first pioneers. At the end of the walk sits Tuttle Cabin, the oldest structure in the county, dating back to 1843. If you love history this is a definite must-see!

Have kiddos with lots of energy? Wonder Spelen Playground is a state-of-the-art, inclusive playground designed for people of all ages and abilities to play together. The main structure is decorated with tulips, a windmill, and Dutch children, celebrating Pella's heritage in the most playful way possible. Grab a to-go lunch at one of our downtown restaurants and have a picnic under the shelter house.

Central Park serves as a picturesque gathering space with its floral gardens, flowering trees, historic fountain, Civil War statue, sundial, and the Tulip Toren. Standing tall, the Tulip Toren is home to many of the annual Tulip Time activities each May!

In the heart of town, the Klokkenspel brings Old World to Pella in a musical way! Performances are daily at 11am, 1pm, 3pm, 5pm, and 9 pm, featuring mechanical figures dressed in traditional Dutch attire that move to the sound of bells. It's a charming display that highlights Pella's rich heritage. For an added dose of culture and entertainment, the Pella Opera House is a stunning historic venue that has been entertaining audiences since 1900. Today, the Opera House is a

premier performing arts venue, hosting concerts, plays, and special events throughout the year. One of its most unique features is the 1928 Barton theatre organ, which adds a touch of vintage charm to performances. The Opera House is also listed on the National Register of Historic Places, making it a must-visit for history buffs and theatre lovers alike.

At the north edge of town, **Big Rock Park** is perfect for hikers and nature lovers, with winding trails leading to the park's namesake—a massive rock formation tucked into the woods. If you enjoy a day on the fairways, **Bos Landen Golf Course**, one of Iowa's top public courses, offers an 18-hole championship layout with stunning scenery. Hiking, Biking, and More

The crown jewel for hikers and bikers is the 17-mile Volksweg Trail, a paved path connecting the charming town of Pella to the lake's recreation areas. As you wind through restored prairies and lush timber, you'll be treated to stunning lake views. Beyond the Volksweg, a network of other trails offers options for all skill levels, including the Elk Rock Equestrian Trail for horseback riding. With additional activities like fishing, boating, and camping, Lake Red Rock truly has something for everyone.



Life on the Water

Lake Red Rock is a paddler's paradise, with calm coves, especially around Robert's Creek, perfect for kayaking and paddleboarding. Anglers can cast a line for catfish, crappie, walleye, and bass, while boaters can enjoy leisurely cruises across the open water. And when it's time to cool off, head to the sandy shores of North Overlook Beach, a popular spot for swimming and sunbathing. Whether you prefer a relaxing day of fishing or a peaceful paddle, the lake offers endless ways to enjoy the water.



Cordova Observation Tower

For the best views of Lake Red Rock, climb the Cordova Observation Tower. This converted water tower, located in Cordova Park, is a massive 106 feet tall with 170 steps to the top. From the viewing platform, you'll be rewarded with breathtaking, panoramic views of the lake, surrounding landscape, and on a clear day, even the nearby towns of Pella and Knoxville. It's a fantastic spot for photography and a great way to appreciate the scale and beauty of the area.




